# Hybrid Canola IH 30 RR



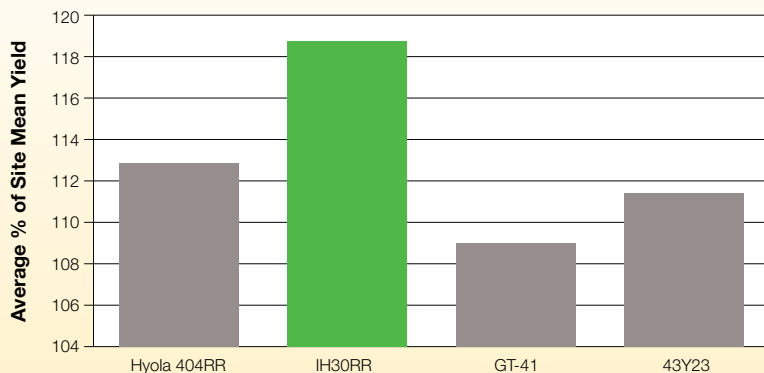
IH30RR suits any canola growing region with less than 300 mm growing season rainfall, and is a good option for later planting in areas with higher rainfall.

# Australia's best low-rainfall performance over 3 years

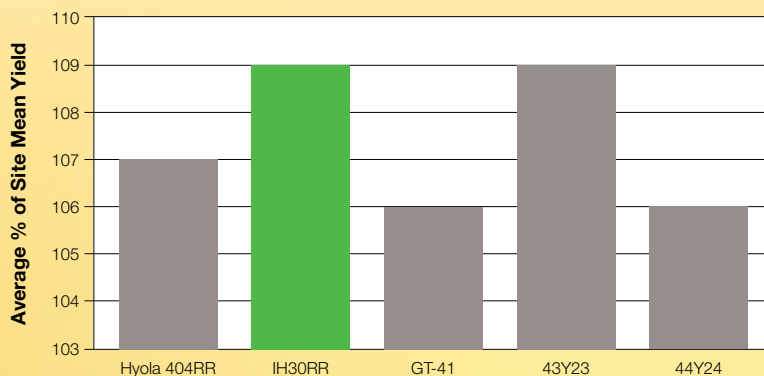
