3	Dry products  Water dispersible granules (WG), Dry flowable (DF), Wettable powders (WP)	Sakura® WG, Triasulfuron, Sharpen®, Diuron 900DF, Roundup Ready® Herbicide with PLANTSHIELD® Technology	Add to the tank gradually, allowing at least 10 minutes for thorough dispersal.
4	Suspension concentrates (SC)	Sakura® Flow, Sencor® 480 SC	Shake drums thoroughly prior to adding and rinse drums into the tank.
5	Emulsifiable concentrates (EC)	Trifluralin, Triallate, Chlorpyrifos, Boxer Gold®, Prosulfocarb, Hammer®, Goal™, Estercide® Xtra 680	
6	Soluble concentrates (SL) (Part A)	Amicide <sup>®</sup> Advance, Spray.Seed <sup>®</sup> , Agritone <sup>®</sup> 750, Kamba <sup>®</sup> , Lontrel <sup>®</sup> Advanced, Gramoxone <sup>®</sup>	
7	Water		Fill to approx. 95% capacity.
8	Soluble concentrates (SL) (Part B)	Roundup Ultra® MAX, Roundup Ready® PL Herbicide with PLANTSHIELD® Technology	
9	Adjuvants / Oils	BS1000, Hasten <sup>®</sup> , Uptake <sup>®</sup> Spray Oil	Add non-water conditioning adjuvants and oils last. Do not allow mixtures to stand unagitated. Add water to 100% of desired volume.

## Please note

- The use of 50 mesh (coarse) filters is recommended.
- Higher water volumes aid compatibility. Minimum water volume of 70 L/ha is recommended.
- When there are multiple products mixed in batching units using low water volumes, compatibility may be reduced.
- When using cold water a longer dispersion time may be required for both Sakura WG and Sakura Flow formulations.
- Spray mixes promptly and don't allow to stand unagitated for long periods.
- If unsure of compatibility, conduct a jar test with same field ratios.
