HOW TO COLLECT A SEED LOADING SAMPLE

1. When collecting a seed sample ensure that a few hundred kilograms of treated seed has passed through the elevator or auger to the silo before filling the sample bag. Fill the sample bag with grain to be tested.
2. Ensure sample bag(s) are clearly marked and dated with the seed type.
Sample bags are to be 300g – 500g in weight.
3. Forward the sample bag(s) and completed seed loading form to your local **Commercial Sales Representative (CSR)**.
4. The results will be returned to you when available. The lab runs seed analysis during the 1st week of every month during the December to May season. Outside this time the lab runs seed analysis on an as-needs basis.

When the results of the sample are available from the Bayer laboratory they will be returned to you with comments. The results are CONFIDENTIAL and all details remain between you and Bayer CropScience.
