General tips for handling chemicals safely

- 1 Hands** are the most exposed part (>95%) of your body during the preparation of the spray mixture. **Protect them.**
- 2 Never handle the undiluted product without gloves.** Wear chemical-resistant gloves when handling any crop protection product to protect the skin.
- 3 Never wear cotton or leather gloves.** They absorb the product and you may be even more exposed each time you wear them.
- 4 Never use damaged gloves; always check them before use.** Change gloves if they are damaged.
- 5 Tuck your shirt sleeves inside your gloves for handling undiluted products.**
- 6 Use gloves as you triple-rinse all the containers used.**
- 7 Use gloves during the cleaning and maintenance of the equipment.**
- 8 Wash gloves every time they get contaminated** before removing them. Washing prolongs the life of the gloves.
- 9 Remove the gloves carefully** (without contaminating the inside) as they can be highly contaminated.
- 10 Do not touch surfaces with contaminated gloves** that will later be touched with unprotected hands.
- 11 Dispose of gloves in a safe way** if they are contaminated. If there is any risk of contamination, always use a new pair.

Avoid contamination of backpack equipment

Avoid filling backpack reservoirs while in backpack holders as spillage of concentrated product could occur. Regularly perform thorough maintenance including checks for any signs of contamination due to spillage or leakage from damaged parts. Routine and regular washing of backpack holders is recommended.
